Dear AASCA Schools,

Village School is excited to be hosting the 2024 - 2025 AASCA Middle and High School Leadership conference in Antigua, Guatemala from September 18 - 22. The conference's title will be "AI-Powered Service: Leading with Innovation and Integrity". We would like to thank all the schools who have pre-confirmed their participation; it has helped us make the necessary arrangements to offer the best experience possible. As a follow up to the Invitation Letter sent in June, we are sharing more details about the conference and the next steps you need to take to ensure your school's participation.

### **Teams and Participants**

We ask each participating school to bring one Middle School and one High School team, each made up of eight students (plus one advisor/chaperone per team, please). These groups should be composed of diverse students, following the AASCA guidelines in regard to the leaders attending: including but not limited to NHS, NJHS, Student Council, GIN, sports, arts, and academic teams captains, etc.

## **Registration and Participation Fee**

The registration fee will be US\$500.00 per team (not per school) so registering for both High School and Middle School would require payment for two teams (US\$1,000). This payment should be done via Wire Transfer using the following information:

We also ask you to complete these <u>Google Form</u> to enroll your teams and confirm participation. Both the payment to Village School and the Google Form must be completed no later than August 19, 2024, please.

## Hotel and Meals Package and Payment

We will be holding this event at Hotel Soleil Antigua with an all-inclusive package of US\$395.00 per participant, with lodging in a triple or quadruple room. (1 bed per student). We kindly request your support in grouping your students as suggested to ensure we have enough rooms for all participants. The package will include the following:

- Thursday, Sept 19: Breakfast, morning and afternoon coffee break, lunch, and dinner.
- Friday, Sept 20: Breakfast, morning and afternoon coffee break, and lunch
- Saturday, Sept 21: Breakfast, morning and afternoon coffee break, and lunch.

\*Village School will provide dinner on Wednesday, September 18 and Saturday, September 21.



Participating AASCA schools will need to fly in and out of La Aurora International Airport (GUA) in Guatemala City. When booking your flights, please take into consideration that there is a 1-hour to 2-hour drive to Antigua depending on traffic. So please plan accordingly as the conference begins Wednesday, September 18, at 5:00 p.m., and all activities will officially end Saturday night. Departure is scheduled to be Sunday, September 22.





Transportation within Antigua will be provided by Village School with shuttles that will be circulating from the hotel to Central Park and back every 15 - 20 mins on Thursday and Friday.
